INDUSTRY DISCUSSION

Rich: What are the students using to shoot video?

Tara: We are mostly using Premiere.

Thomas: Premiere, Final Cut. It just depends who they are working for. We might be teaching Premiere and Final Cut and then they end up shooting Seeing a lot of people who are still specialized. It's probably driven by budgets.

Brett: Question in regards to our ERP implementation.

Thomas: You really need a commercial and PR campaign.

Brett: Is the system itself is flawed? Why can't you go back to what you were using before?

Pacific now has labs at 4 units. We will have to work out how to do that here with Delta to maintain all articulation. I don't see it being an issue but we will work it out.

Thomas: Business classes to make their business viable will be necessary for student.

Tara: We have new social media classes that look at the business angle or our areas.

Adriana: Discussion of RTV offered-degrees, hoping to increase offerings with new courses. She said for 3 years RTV issued 29 degrees. The plan is to change the curriculum to increase that to 40 plus.

Rich: Too many newspapers have bad video with terrible audio quality. *The Collegian* is doing great. The video looks good.

Adriana: The one thing that I would add the whole thing was to get them out in three years. Stackable certificates are the same thing. When you do consolidate this please make sure to keep the rigor and catch the students who

Rich and Thomas: advocating for internships and work-based experiences to be reflected in the revised degree changes.

Tara: Asking for lab techs and entree to employment events in Spring 2020 and Fall 2020. Also pitching the idea of a Social Media Saturday. Capped at 25 people. Thinking about proposing this

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Kirstyn: It is a silly logistical issue but serious studio lighting is a necessary skill for our students.

Tara: Facility issues and lack of lab space.

Melanie: Adobe certification will be available for all SJDC multimedia students in

February. Animation

Thomas: Certification shows that you can do the job and that is the test for the most

part, and they can put it on a resume. IT is all about certification.

EQUIPMENT NEEDS

Tara: Continued support for SWP more than anything.

Adriana: Livestreaming using Sling units to, which benefit the public by allowing greater streaming.

Melanie: 15 new iMacs, 64 gigs of Ram, new color laser printer, 12X18 with a color calibration system, color photo printer

Kirstyn: Portable unit taken outside, portable strobe lights, portable editing on a laptop might be tricky, Right now I am researching computers, DSLR and SLR and Perkins doesn't buy used equipment. We do get donations and that is helpful.
