

# Labor Market Information Report Virtual Production Occupations Regional Virtual Production Academy

(Diablo Valley College, Berkeley City College, Laney College, Ohlone College, Santa Rosa Junior College and Mission College)

#### Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of Virtual Production workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region, the East Bay sub-region (Alameda, Contra Costa counties), the North Bay sub-region (Marin, Solano, Napa and Sonoma counties) and Silicon Valley sub-region (Santa Clara county). There is a projected annual gap of about 935 students in the Bay region, 213 students in the Silicon Valley sub-region, 183 students in the East Bay sub-region and 51 students in the North Bay sub-region.

### Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0699.00 - Other Media and Communications programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region.

This report profiles Virtual Production Occupations in the 12 county Bay region, East Bay sub-region, North Bay sub-region and Silicon Valley sub-region for a Regional Virtual Production Academy at Diablo Valley College, Berkeley City College, Laney College, Ohlone College, Santa Rosa Junior College and Mission College.

• Special Effects Artists and Animators (27-1014): Create special effects, animation, or other visual images using film, video, computers, or other electronic tools and media for use in products or creations, such as computer games, movies, music videos, and commercials.

• **Producers and Directors (27-2012):** Produce or direct stage, television, radio, video, or motion picture productions for entertainment, information, or instruction. Responsible for creative decisions, such as interpretation of script, choice of actors or guests, set design, sound, special effects, and choreography.

# **Educational Supply**

There is one (1) community college in the Bay Region and Silicon Valley Sub-Region (San Jose City College) issuing two (2) awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2019-20) on TOP 0699.00 – Other Media and Communications.

There are a two (2) other educational institutions in the Bay Region issuing 11 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2019-20) on CIP 09.9999 - Communication, Journalism and Related Programs, Other. There is one (1) other educational institution in the East Bay Sub-Region issuing one (1) award on average annually (last 3 years) on this CIP code. There is one (1) other educational institution in the North Bay Sub-Region issuing 10 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this CIP code. There are no other educational institution in the Silicon Valley Sub-Region issuing awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this CIP code.

## **Gap Analysis**

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay region with 946 annual openings for the Virtual Production occupational cluster and 11 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 935 students.

In the Silicon Valley Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 215 annual openings and two (2) annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 213 students.

In the East Bay Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 184 annual openings and one (1) annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 183 students.

In the North Bay Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 61 annual openings and 10 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 51 students.
