

Program Endorsement Brief: 0612.20/Film Production Associates Degree in Visual Effects and Certificate of Achievement in Visual Effects

Los Angeles/Orange County Center of Excellence, October 2018

Summary:

The Los Angeles/Orange County Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research (COE) prepared this report to provide regional labor market supply and demand data related to visual effects. This report is intended to help determine whether there is demand in the local labor market that is not being met by the supply from community college programs that align with relevant occupations.

The following summarizes key findings from this data brief:

- The number of jobs for graphic designers, film and video editors, multimedia artists and animators is projected to increase by 5% through 2022. Nearly 4,500 job openings will be available annually due to new job growth and replacement need.
- Over the past 12 months, there were 2,124 online job postings related to the three occupations of interest in the region.
- In Los Angeles/Orange County, there are 24 colleges that may train for the occupations studied in this report.
- Between 2014 and 2017, community colleges in the region conferred an average of 356 awards (associate degrees and certificates) in related training programs.

Occupational Demand—In Los Angeles/Orange County, the number of jobs for graphic designers, film and video editors, and multimedia artists and animators is projected to increase by 5%. There will be nearly 4,500 job openings per year through 2022 (Exhibit 1).

Wages—Entry-level hourly wages for the three occupations of interest in the region are between \$12.23 and \$18.96. Entry-level wages for film and video editors are higher than the MIT Living hourly wage for one adult in the region (\$13.54 in Los Angeles County, \$15.31 in Orange County). Experienced workers earn between \$40.09 and \$101.64/hour, which is higher than the living wage. Regional wages are above the average statewide wage for the occupations.

¹ Five-year change represents new job additions to the workforce. Annual openings include new jobs and replacement jobs that result from retirements and separations.

Job Postings—There were 2,124 online job postings related to the three occupations of interest listed in the past 12 months. The majority of job postings were for: graphic designers, video editors, and animators. Top specialized skills include: graphic design, Adobe programs (Photoshop, InDesign, Illustrator, Acrobat, Creative Suite, After Effects), and video editing.

Educational Attainment—The BLS lists a Bachelor's degree as the typical entry-level education for these occupations. The national-level educational attainment data indicates between 27% and 30% of workers in the field have completed some college or an associate degree. Of job postings including a minimum education requirement in Los Angeles/Orange County, 50% request at least a high school diploma or vocational training.

Community College Supply—Appendix A shows the annual and three-year average number of awards conferred by community colleges in the related TOP codes: Film Production (0612.20), Digital Media (0614.00), Multimedia (0614.10), Animation (0614.40), Computer Graphics and Digital Imagery (0614.60). Between January and September 2018, there were two other related program recommendation requests from regional community colleges.
