Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Office workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region (Monterey, San Benito, and Santa Cruz Counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 11,084 students in the Bay region and 704 students in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

Introduction

This report profiles Office Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region for an existing Office Software low unit, local certificate(s) at Cabrillo College for state chaptering.

- **Procurement Clerks (43-3061):** Compile information and records to draw up purchase orders for procurement of materials and services.
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent
Training Requirement: Moderate-term on-the-job training
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 34%
- **Data Entry Keyers (43-9021):** Operate data entry device, such as keyboard or photo composing perforator. Duties may include verifying data and preparing materials for printing. Excludes "Word Processors and Typists" (43-9022).

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 46%
- **Word Processors and Typists (43-9022):** Use word processor, computer or typewriter to type letters, reports, forms, or other material from rough draft, corrected copy, or voice recording. May perform other clerical duties as assigned. Excludes "Data Entry Keyers" (43-9021), "Secretaries and Administrative Assistants" (43-6011 through 43-6014), "Court Reporters" (23-2091), and "Medical Transcriptionists" (31-9094).
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent
Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 46%
- **Office Clerks, General (43-9061):** Perform duties too varied and diverse to be classified in any specific office clerical occupation, requiring knowledge of office systems and procedures. Clerical duties may be assigned in accordance with the office procedures of individual establishments and may include a combination of answering telephones, bookkeeping, typing or word processing, stenography, office machine operation, and filing.
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent
Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 44%

- **Statistical Assistants (43-9111):** Compile and compute data according to statistical formulas for use in statistical studies. May perform actuarial computations and compile charts and graphs for use by actuaries. Includes actuarial clerks.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Bachelor's degree

Training Requirement: None

Educational Supply

There are 21 community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 209 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications. There are two colleges in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region issuing 49 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

There are six (6) Other Educational Institutions in the Bay Region issuing 152 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2016-17) on TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications. There are two Other Educational Institutions in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region issuing 61 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 11,445 annual openings for the Office occupational cluster and 361 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and Other Educational Institutions for an annual undersupply of 11,084 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 814 annual openings and 110 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and Other Educational Institutions for an annual undersupply of 704 students.
