- Consider adding green screen event photography content.
- Consider adding content to cover drone photography.
- Explore 360-degree photography used in Google Maps for business images.

## **Equipment and Facilities**

- Introduce large format printers to the classroom studio.
- Create a stand-alone lighting studio (essential for portrait and commercial product photography).
