Minutes

- 1. Review progress of Rehab Aide and OTA curriculum
 - Rehab aide program to begin Spring 2019
 - ACOTE standards to be released August 31, 2018
 - Will need to adjust curriculum design and course content based upon new standards
- 2. New OTA course: Contemporary Models and Emerging Areas in Occupational Therapy
 - Based upon recent changes in the Occupational Therapy profession, a class specifically devoted to contemporary models and emerging areas need to be developed.
 - Originally part of psychosocial course
 - Vea called for a vote to have students attend the Summer session to retain information prior to Fieldwork Level II in Fall semester, Year 3
 - Members suggested holding evening classes three nights a week, instead of proposed four nights a week. Suggested starting earlier, around 5:00 P.M. and offering Saturday classes
 - Members suggested reducing the first cohort size from 30 to 25 students
 - **Unanimous vote by 10 Advisory committee members to have students attend Summer session, hold evening classes three nights a week, with the option of some Saturday classes, and reduction of cohort size to 25 students.
- Updates in Occupational Therapy
 - Changes in Medicare will require OTA students to document for skilled OT services
- 2. Review equipment inventory list
 - More pediatric assessments and furniture will be needed
 - Will hold on purchasing apartment furniture for simulated living space until classroom is determined, by start of first cohort in Fall 2020
- 3. View space for classroom and labs
- 4. Discussion on Rehabilitation Aide Externship and Fieldwork Placement Sites
 - 150 fieldwork level I sites (50 pediatric, 50 psychosocial, 50 physical dysfunction), 200 fieldwork level II sites, 20 rehab aide sites
- 5. Tentative 2-year Plan
 - Fall 2018 Create OTA courses, establish 20 rehab aide externship sites
 - Spring 2019 Start Rehab Aide program, start creating OTA courses, establish 150 fieldwork level I sites
 - Fall 2019 Continue creating OTA courses, start handbooks, establish 200 fieldwork level II sites
 - Spring 2020 Finish creating OTA courses, finish handbooks
- 6. Employment Opportunities
 - Part-time position will open for someone to establish rehab aide externship sites and fieldwork sites
