1. Call to Order
 - a. Facilitator Sean Osborn called the meeting to order on November 23, 2021, at 2:00 pm.

3. Approval of minutes from last meeting
 - a. This was the first meeting of the Advisory committee. There were no previous minutes to approve.

 - a. Discussion of the Beginning Social Work SAC and the Social Work and Human Services COA. Mr. Osborn opened the discussion with information about the recently discontinued Human Services AA and the Peer Support SAC. This was important background information necessary to lay the foundation for the creation of the new SAC and COA awards. The course requirements for the SAC and COA were shared with the committee. An explanation of the chosen courses was provided and reviewed by the committee. Mr. Osborn also provided an explanation of how the SAC stacks into the COA and how the COA can then lead to students taking a pathway to either a Social and Behavioral Science degree (AA) or a Social Work and Human Services degree for transfer (AA-T). Ms. Rogers provided feedback on how the courses in these degrees could benefit Tuolumne County Social Services. Ms. Carlson confirmed the COA would meet the minimum requirements for entry level jobs within the Tuolumne County Health and Human Services office. Ms. Carlson asked several questions about the program and provided valuable feedback. Ultimately Ms. Carlson said the SAC and COA awards made sense to her as they are listed. She also said she was in full support of the awards and the creation of the new Social Work and Human Services AA-T. Ms. Carlson said she would be interested in providing a field placement site for students. She also provided the name of the Welfare-to-Work supervisor as another person in the county who she believed would be very interested in these awards and possible field placement.
