- Palm Springs Film Lab Opened January of 2019
- Temporary, part time lab technician working to manage and maintain equipment
- A full schedule of film production courses are now offered on COD's Temporary Palm Springs Campus
- 2 Certificates and 2 Degrees have been approved
- Designation of Film instead of RTV
- More courses being offered starting Fall 2019
- A third certificate in the works
- Working with the local municipalities

Micro Courses

- Serves a way to discuss the different facets of jobs within the film industry
- Allow students to find their niche

- An A la carte system
- 1 or 1.5 credit courses over 8 weeks

Additional Certificates / Degrees

- Film Producer Certificate
 - Making a track with in the existing courses where students would be able to assume the producer role
 - Apply this methodology to other roles?
- Production Management Certificate
 - o Includes courses in location management, producing, marketing and distribution, film festival, production assistant, craft

Challenge: Integrating Budgeting into the Curriculum

Possible Solutions

- Students raise money for capstone film
 - o Precedent exists in the University of California System
- School creates a "Disney bucks" type of budget
 - Each student / group gets a certain allotment of bucks provided by the school and the student is responsible for budgeting it as if it were actually money

Activating the Advisory Committee

- Using the advisory committee as guest speakers / lecturers within existing courses
 - Internships available at Palm Springs Film Festival in Marketing, Social Media, Programming, Guest Relations, Forums and Shorts, Production, Awards Gala, Sponsorship and Development
 - o Workshops with film makers from the Palm Springs Film Festival
- Using the committee as a source for internships / job opportunities for students
- Bringing in folks from the industry who have experience, but not necessarily masters degrees to teach as an adjunct

Partnerships

- Integration between Palm Spring's High School & COD's Film Departments
- Palm Springs municipality for permits established
 - Need to develop partnership with other local municipalities & tribal governments
 - Aqua Caliente Tribe allows for Film students to film on their land for free
