

Program Endorsement Brief: 3007.00/Cosmetology and Barbering Salon Business

Los Angeles/Orange County Center of Excellence, March 2019

The Los Angeles/Orange County Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research (COE) prepared this brief to provide regional labor market supply and demand data related to salon business. This report is intended to help determine whether there is demand in the local labor market that is not being met by the supply from community college programs that align with relevant occupations.

The following summarizes key findings:

- Over the past 12 months, there were over 228 online job postings for salon and spa managers in Los Angeles/Orange County.¹
- Top employers include Great Clips, Ulta Beauty, Supercuts, Regis Corporation, and JCPenney.
- All job postings request a high school diploma or vocational training.
- Between 2014 and 2017, community colleges in the region conferred an average of 825 awards (associate degrees and certificates) in related training programs.
- No other related program recommendation requests were received between January 2018 and February 2019.
