 - Biocom - an organization that puts on a conference every Spring coordinated with STEM. Students just finished fabric designs based on images from scientific industry. The inspiration designs were based on images from Salk institute. There will be a request for funding from the foundation to print 20 fabrics based on the winning designs and to have a student make a full garment. Spoonflower is an independent company that has been approach about printing the fabrics and is interested in printing the fabrics.
