

Interior Designers Labor Market Information Report Chabot College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research October 2018

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Interior Designers compared to the demand for this occupation in the Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region (Alameda and Contra Costa Counties). The annual gap is about 403 students annually in the Bay region and 103 in the East Bay Sub-Region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for programs on TOP 1302.00 - Interior Design and Merchandising in the state and region. It is recommended that this data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Chabot College and in the region.

Introduction

This report profiles Interior Designers in the 12 county Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region for a proposed Kitchen and Bathroom Certificate program at Chabot College.

• Interior Designers (SOC 27-1025): Plan, design, and furnish interiors of residential, commercial, or industrial buildings. Formulate design which is practical, aesthetic, and conducive to intended purposes, such as raising productivity, selling merchandise, or improving life style. May specialize in a particular field, style, or phase of interior design. Excludes "Merchandise Displayers and Window Trimmers" (27-1026).

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Bachelor's degree

Training Requirement: None

There are 10 community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 82 awards annually on TOP 1302.00 - Interior Design and Merchandising. There are five colleges in the East Bay Sub-Region issuing 20 awards annually on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay region with 485 annual openings for Interior Designers and 82 annual awards for an annual undersupply of 403 students. In the East Bay Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 123 annual openings and 20 annual awards for an annual undersupply of 103 students.

Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data.
