



### Light Hiring Competition Over a Deep Supply of Regional Talent





#### **Job Posting Demand**


Competition from online job postings is low in Kern County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 15\* job postings/mo, while there are 11 here.

### Regional Employment Is Higher Than the National Average





### Compensation

#### Regional Compensation Is 6% Lower Than National Compensation

In 2018, the median compensation for Educational, Guidance, School, and Vocational Counselors in Kern County, CA is \$52,749. Based on the national median wage of \$56,306 for this position, this means you will spend about 6% less to employ Educational, Guidance, School, and Vocational Counselors here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 20% less than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 17% higher than average). This may make it harder to attract talent to the region at this price.







### Retirement Risk Is High, While Overall Diversity Is High




#### **Retiring Soon**

Racial diversity is high in Kern County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 241\* racially diverse employees, while there are 398 here.




#### **Gender Diversity**

Gender diversity is high in Kern County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 461\* female employees, while there are 541 here.



### Occupation Race/Ethnicity Breakdown




### **Occupation Gender Breakdown**
