

# Musical Theater Occupations Labor Market Information Report West Valley College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research April 2020

#### Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Musical Theater workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the Silicon Valley sub-region (Santa Clara County). There is a projected annual gap of about 1,176 students in the Bay region and 373 students in the Silicon Valley Sub-Region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for programs on TOP 1099.00 - Other Fine and Applied Arts in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at West Valley College and in the region.

#### Introduction

This report profiles Musical Theater Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the Silicon Valley sub-region for a proposed new program at West Valley College.

 Actors (SOC 27-2011): Play parts in stage, television, radio, video, motion picture productions, or other settings for entertainment, information, or instruction. Interpret serious or comic role by speech, gesture, and body movement to entertain or inform audience. May dance and sing.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Some college, no degree

Training Requirement: Long-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 29%

 Musicians and Singers (SOC 27-2042): Play one or more musical instruments or sing. May perform on stage, for on-air broadcasting, or for sound or video recording.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: No formal educational credential

Training Requirement: Long-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 25%

Dancers (SOC 27-2031): Perform dances. May perform on stage, for on-air broadcasting, or for video recording

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: No formal educational credential

Training Requirement: Long-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 31%

• **Choreographers (SOC 27-2032):** Create new dance routines. Rehearse performance of routines. May direct and stage presentations.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: Long-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 31%

# **Educational Supply**

There are no community colleges in the Bay Region issuing awards on average annually (last 3 years) on TOP 1099.00 - Other Fine and Applied Arts.

Note: The annual average for awards is 2015-16 to 2017-18.

### **Gap Analysis**

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay region with 1,176 annual openings for the Musical Theater occupational cluster and no annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 1,176 students. In the Silicon Valley Sub-Region there is also a gap with 373 annual openings and no annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 373 students.

Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data.
