

# Bookkeeping Occupations Labor Market Information Report Cabrillo College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research
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#### Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of Bookkeeping workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region (Monterey, San Benito, and Santa Cruz counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 12,735 students in the Bay region and 957 students in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

#### Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0502.00 - Accounting programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

This report profiles Bookkeeping Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region for existing low unit, local certificate(s) for state chaptering at Cabrillo College.

Billing and Posting Clerks (43-3021): Compile, compute, and record billing, accounting, statistical, and other
numerical data for billing purposes. Prepare billing invoices for services rendered or for delivery or shipment of
goods.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: Moderate-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 46%

Bookkeeping, Accounting, and Auditing Clerks (43-3031): Compute, classify, and record numerical data to
keep financial records complete. Perform any combination of routine calculating, posting, and verifying duties to
obtain primary financial data for use in maintaining accounting records. May also check the accuracy of figures,
calculations, and postings pertaining to business transactions recorded by other workers. Excludes "Payroll and
Timekeeping Clerks" (43-3051).

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Some college, no degree

Training Requirement: Moderate-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 49%

• Office Clerks, General (43-9061): Perform duties too varied and diverse to be classified in any specific office clerical occupation, requiring knowledge of office systems and procedures. Clerical duties may be assigned in accordance with the office procedures of individual establishments and may include a combination of answering telephones, bookkeeping, typing or word processing, stenography, office machine operation, and filing.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

## **Educational Supply**

There are 28 community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 809 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0502.00 - Accounting. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there are three (3) community colleges that issued 68 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

## **Gap Analysis**

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 13,544 annual openings for the Bookkeeping occupational cluster and 809 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 12,735 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 1,025 annual openings and 68 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 957 students.

Occupations for this report were identified by use of skills listed in O\*Net descriptions and job descriptions in Burning Glass. Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCO Data Mart.
