

Commercial Photography Occupations Labor Market Information Report Cabrillo College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research December 2020

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Commercial Photography workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay Region and in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region (Monterey, San Benito, and Santa Cruz Counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 1,886 students in the Bay Region and 91 students in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 1012.00-Applied Photography programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

This report profiles Commercial Photography Occupations in the 12 county Bay Region and in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region for a proposed new program at Cabrillo College.

 Photographers (27-4021): Photograph people, landscapes, merchandise, or other subjects, using digital or film cameras and equipment. May develop negatives or use computer software to produce finished images and prints. Includes scientific photographers, aerial photographers, and photojournalists.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: Moderate-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 34%

• **Film and Video Editors (27-4032):** Edit moving images on film, video, or other media. May edit or synchronize soundtracks with images. Excludes "Sound Engineering Technicians" (27-4014).

Educational Supply

There are six (6) community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 45 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 1012.00-Applied Photography. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region there are no community colleges that issued awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

There are three (3) other CTE Educational Institutions in the Bay Region issuing 57 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2016-17) on TOP 1012.00-Applied Photography. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region there are no other CTE Educational Institutions that issued awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay Region with 1,988 annual openings for the Commercial Photography occupational cluster and 102 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and other institutions for an annual undersupply of 1,886 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 91 annual openings and no annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and other institutions for an annual undersupply of 91 students.
