

Customer Relationship Management Occupations Labor Market Information Report Cabrillo College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research August 2020

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be a significant undersupply of Customer Relationship Management workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region (Monterey, San Benito, and Santa Cruz Counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 9,670 students in the Bay region and 604 students in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

Introduction

This report profiles Customer Relationship Management Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region for state chaptering of an existing low unit, local certificate - Customer Relationship Management (CRM) - at Cabrillo College.

Procurement Clerks (43-3061): Compile information and records to draw up purchase orders for procurement of materials and services.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent Training Requirement: Moderate-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 34%

Order Clerks (43-4151): Receive and process incoming orders for materials, merchandise, classified ads, or services such as repairs, installations, or rental of facilities. Generally receives orders via mail, phone, fax, or other electronic means. Duties include informing customers of receipt, prices, shipping dates, and delays; preparing contracts; and handling complaints. Excludes "Dispatchers, Except Police, Fire, and Ambulance" (43-5032) who both dispatch and take orders for services.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Some college, no degree

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 37%

First-Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers (41-1011): Directly supervise and coordinate activities of retail sales workers in an establishment or department. Duties may include management functions, such as purchasing, budgeting, accounting, and personnel work, in addition to supervisory duties.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: None

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 38%

• First-Line Supervisors of Non-Retail Sales Workers (41-1012): Directly supervise and coordinate activities of sales workers other than retail sales workers. May perform duties, such as budgeting, accounting, and personnel work, in addition to supervisory duties.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: None

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 30%

• First-Line Supervisors of Office and Administrative Support Workers (43-1011): Directly supervise and coordinate the activities of clerical and administrative support workers.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: None

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 39%

Educational Supply

There are 21 community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 209 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications. There are two colleges in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region issuing 49 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

There are six (6) Other Educational Institutions in the Bay Region issuing 152 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2016-17) on TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications. There are two Other Educational Institutions in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region issuing 61 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 10,031 annual openings for the Customer Relationship Management occupational cluster and 361 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and Other Educational Institutions for an annual undersupply of 9,670 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 714 annual openings and 110 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and Other Educational Institutions for an annual undersupply of 604 students.
