

Dental Hygienist Occupations Labor Market Information Report Chabot College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research March 2019

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Dental Hygienist workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region (Alameda and Contra Costa Counties.) There is a projected annual gap of about 2,120 students in the Bay region and 687 students in the East Bay Sub-Region when demand for Dental Hygienists and Dental Assistants is combined. If only the demand for Dental Hygienists is used (excluding Dental Assistants) and compared to the supply for TOP 1240.20 (Dental Hygienist), there is still a projected annual gap of about 421 students in the Bay region and 116 students in the East Bay Sub-Region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for programs on TOP 1240.20 - Dental Hygienist in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Chabot College and in the region.

Introduction

This report profiles Dental Hygienist Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region for the program review process at Chabot College.

• **Dental Hygienists (SOC 29-2021):** Clean teeth and examine oral areas, head, and neck for signs of oral disease. May educate patients on oral hygiene, take and develop x rays, or apply fluoride or sealants.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Associate's degree

Training Requirement: None

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 59%

 Dental Assistants (SOC 31-9091): Assist dentist, set up equipment, prepare patient for treatment, and keep records.

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 61%

Educational Supply

There are five community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 101 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on TOP 1240.20 - Dental Hygienist. There are two colleges in the East Bay Sub-Region issuing 37 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay region with 2,221 annual openings for the Dental Hygienist occupational cluster and 101 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 2,120 students. In the East Bay Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 724 annual openings and 37 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 687 students.

If only the demand for Dental Hygienists is used (excluding Dental Assistants) and compared to the supply for TOP 1240.20 (Dental Hygienist), there is still a projected annual undersupply of about 421 students in the Bay region and 116 students in the East Bay Sub-Region.

Occupations for this report were identified by use of skills listed in O*Net descriptions and job descriptions in Burning Glass. Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCO Data Mart.
