Program Recommendation

This report was compiled by the South Central Coast¹ Center of Excellence to provide regional labor market data for the program recommendation – Athletic Training and Sports Medicine. This report can help determine whether there is demand in the local labor market that is not being met by the supply from programs of study (CCC and non-CCC) that align with this occupation group.

Key Findings

- In the South Central Coast region, the number of jobs related to Sports Medicine are expected to increase for Physical Therapist Assistants and Physical Therapist Aides.
- Physical Therapist Assistants and Physical Therapist Aides are anticipated to experience a low risk of automation in the coming years.
- In 2020 there were 197 regional completions in programs related to the occupations identified as aligned with Sports Medicine and 141 openings, indicating an **oversupply**.
- Typical entry-level education is an Associate's degree for Physical Therapist Assistants and a High School
 Diploma or Equivalent for Physical Therapist Aides.
- Completers of regional Sports Medicine programs from the 2017-2018 academic year had a **median** annual wage upon completion of \$21,128.
- 65% of students are employed within a year after completing a program.
- 51% of students were part time, 31% first-generation, and 79% economically disadvantaged.
- +92% change in earnings for completers.

¹ The South Central Coast Region consists of San Luis Obispo County, Santa Barbara County, Ventura County, and the following cities from North Los Angeles County: Canyon Country, Castaic, Lake Hughes, Lancaster, Littlerock, Llano, Newhall, Palmdale, Pearblossom, Santa Clarita, Stevenson Ranch, and Valencia.

Occupation Codes and Descriptions

There are two occupations in the standard occupational classification (SOC) system that were identified as related to Sports Medicine for this analysis. The occupation titles and descriptions, as well as reported job titles are included in Exhibit 1.

Current and Future Employment

Earnings

In the South Central Coast region, the average wage for the listed occupations is \$24.96 per hour.

Exhibit 3 contains hourly wages and annual average earnings for this occupation. Entry-level hourly earnings are represented by the 25th percentile of wages, median hourly earnings are represented by the 50th percentile of wages, and experienced hourly earnings are represented by the 75th percentile of wages, demonstrating various levels of employment.

Employer Job Postings

In this research brief, real-time labor market information is used to provide a more nuanced view of the current job market, as it captures job advertisements for occupations relevant to the field of study. Employer job postings are consulted to understand who is looking for physical therapy assistants and aides, and what they are looking for in potential candidates. To identify job postings related to Sports Medicine the following standard occupational classifications were used:

Notes

Data included in this analysis represent the labor market demand for relevant positions most closely related to Sports Medicine. Traditional labor market information was used to show current and projected employment based on data trends, as well as annual average awards granted by regional community colleges. Real-time labor market information captures job post advertisements for occupations relevant to the field of study and can signal demand and show what employers are looking for in potential employees, but is not a perfect measure of the quantity of open positions. All representations have been produced from primary research and/or secondary review of publicly and/or privately available data and/or research reports. The most recent data available at the time of the analysis was examined; however, data sets are updated regularly and may not be consistent with previous reports. Efforts have been made to qualify and validate the accuracy of the data and findings; however, neither the Centers of Excellence for Labor Market Research (COE), COE host district, nor California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office are responsible for the applications or decisions made by individuals and/or organizations based on this study or its recommendations.
