Re: LMI for Non-Credit Certificate, Sustainable Construction and Energy Technology-Introduction to Construction Trades

Background

Mendocino College requested labor market information for a new Non-Credit Certificate in Sustainable Construction and Energy Technology- Introduction to Construction Trades. Local advisory committees support the proposed certificate.

This memo uses the Strong Workforce Program labor market information template (Exhibit 1) to provide a summary of occupational demand for related middle-skill occupations and educational program supply in the North/Far North region. The findings below summarize the data analysis shown in exhibit 1.

Findings

- Community colleges in the North/Far North region conferred an average of 144 certificates and degrees in TOP codes 0952.00 – Construction Crafts Technology and 0952.10 – Carpentry (2017-2018 through 2019-2020).
- There are 2,419 projected annual openings over the next five years in the related middle-skill occupations of carpenter (SOC 47-2031).
- Related lower-than middle skill occupations including construction labors (SOC 47-2061), helperscarpenters (SOC 47-3012), and miscellaneous construction and related workers (SOC 47-4098) are projected to increase by an average of 13% over the next five years.
- Median hourly earnings for carpenters, as well as the related lower-than middle skill occupations mentioned above, are higher than the aveage living wage for a single adult in the region.
