

Medical Assistants Labor Market Information Report Merritt College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research February 2021

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Medical Assistants compared to the demand for this occupation in the Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region (Alameda and Contra Costa Counties). The gap is about 2,600 students annually in the Bay region and 874 students annually in the East Bay sub-region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for programs on TOP 1208.10 - Clinical Medical Assisting in the state and region. It is recommended that this data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Merritt College and in the region.

Introduction

This report profiles Medical Assistants in the 12 county Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region for a proposed new program at Merritt College.

Medical Assistants (SOC 31-9092): Perform administrative and certain clinical duties under the direction of a
physician. Administrative duties may include scheduling appointments, maintaining medical records, billing, and
coding information for insurance purposes. Clinical duties may include taking and recording vital signs and
medical histories, preparing patients for examination, drawing blood, and administering medications as
directed by physician. Excludes "Physician Assistants" (29-1071).

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 2,669 annual openings for the Medical Assistants and 69 annual awards for an annual undersupply of 2,600 students. In the East Bay sub-region, there is also a gap with 874 annual openings and no annual awards for an annual undersupply of 874 students.

Occupations for this report were identified by use of skills listed in O*Net descriptions and job descriptions in Burning Glass. Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCO Data Mart.
