Madera Community College is adding two new classes to the catalog. Crim 9 – Advanced Criminal Investigations and Crim 16 – Forensic Photography. In the Spring 2022, we plan to add a new Criminology Certificate of Achievement in Crime Scene Investigation. It was approved unanimously by the members. A new full-time Crim instructor position has been requested. We will know if the request has been accepted by November.
