 - Copper Mountain - Adult Ed (Drone program, personal trainer.) Groundman Program (partnering with So Cal Edison) in the future.
 - Chaffey - Developing non credit makerspace. Chaffey invited MV to bring their mobile makerspace to visit the campus.
 - Discussed MSJC and MV bringing their mobile labs to the college as a regional resource.
 - SBVC - Welding and Applied Technology mirroring the credit side of the house
